Day of preparation
Last supper
(this is not THE Passover
dinner)
Disciples walk with
Jesus to Garden of
Gethsemane

Wednesday

- Midnight - Arrested
by soldiers
- Illegal trial:
Annas and Caiaphas
- Peter Denies Christ 3x
- Jesus condemned to
die by the Jewish
leaders
- Judas hangs himself
- Only a Roman can
crucify, so Jewish
leaders go to Pilate,
then to Herod, and
back to Pilate
- Jesus given crown of
thorns and drags
cross thru streets of
Jerusalem to
Golgotha, Simeon
helps
- He is Crucified
around noon
- Darkness covers the
land for 3 hours
- He dies at 3pm
- The sepulcher is
sealed by 6pm
- The Passover lamb is
also killed today
between 3-5pm

Thursday DAY 1

(Wednesday 6pm to
Thursday at 6pm)

High Holy Day
The Passover Feast
Family gather and partake of
the Lamb. Remembering
their rescue from Egypt

**3 Days and 3 Nights
Like Jonah and the
whale.**

Friday DAY 2

(Thursday 6pm to
Friday 6pm)

Friday Morning:
Women Buy and Prepare
Spices to finish preparing
Jesus' body

**Just like 3 days and
3 nights of darkness
in the Book of
Mormon**

Saturday DAY 3

(Friday 6pm to
Saturday 6pm)

Jewish Sunday
Day of Rest

**From 6pm on
Wednesday to 6pm
on Saturday =
3 days and 3 nights**
